After years of an artistic engagement with domestic and local themes, Anat betzer is now painting fields of snow, deep dark forests, huge tree trunks, wooden huts, all objects of her soul's desire.

In this type of painting the forest becomes a detailed icon, elaborately explored and drawn in various kinds of light, where each and every leaf is being examined.

Alienation is pronounced on several levels; in shedding off local iconography, in distancing oneself from the domestic/local context and even when dealing specifically with life's end.

Snowy wilderness, unpopulated frosted nothingness, the open space of the depicted landscape, the squares, all these actually produce a kind of death. In paintings of high realism there is principle at work which is similar to the one that exists in abstract paintings, that is the large gap between the very act of painting as a message of life, vitality and creativity vs. the narrow, monotonic void presented on the canvas.

Paint layers which drip, "dirt", and cover the surface of the canvas are hinting that this is not an innocent landscape, but rather one that hides, at least potentially, other, deeper archeological layers.

Just as the thematic level within the painting bars any possibility of evaluating the forest's dimensions, number of trees or their age, similarly, the method by which they are painted, produces a formula for potential eternity. Thus, a romantic, nostalgic sentiment evokes a discussion about futility, cessation, loneliness, alienation, and an ultimate realization of the void is revealed.

All paintings are oil on canvas.



















Untitled, 2009, oil on canvas, 28 x 51 cm



































Untitled, 2009, oil on canvas, 140 x 95 cm
